



## **A REPORT ON -CHILDREN'S DAY CELEBRATIONS AT UPENDRANATH BRAHMA M.E SCHOOL (FFS)**

A team activity had students collaboratively drawing ideal, eco-friendly dustbins, leading to the placement of locally curated bamboo dustbins across the school. ### **2. Workshop on Natural Dyeing Process**

Conducted by Ms. Krisky Sangma, a dyeing expert, the workshop showcased the step-wise process of natural dyeing using locally available ingredients like turmeric, onion peel, and henna leaves. The impact included easy learning, sustainable revenue generation opportunities for the community, and increased awareness of eco-friendly dyeing practices.
